TERMS & REGULATIONS

- Photographer must be age 16 or older.
- Photographer may submit a maximum of 4 entries.
- Each entry must be:
 - __Original analog or digital print completed in the last two years and not previously entered in this exhibition. Original work is the photographer's sole creation, not created with the aid of an instructor or as a copy, in any part, of another's work.
 - __Minimum print size of 8"x10" and maximum print size of 20"x24" mounted on 1/4" foam core or gator board. Matting optional. No frames, hooks, Velcro, or plastic wrapped entries. Sponsor will attach adhesive hanging tabs to the back of each mounted print.
 - __Clearly labeled on back with photographer's name & phone.
- Permitted edits in Monochrome and Color: cropping, lightening, darkening, focus adjustment, dodging, color balance or correction, de-specking, burning, and lens distortion correction.
- Sponsor reserves the right to change an entry's category if another category deems more appropriate.
- Title cards for each entry will be filled out on site.
- \$5 per entry is due at drop-off. Entry fee is paid by cash, credit card, or check made payable to the City of North Charleston. Non-refundable.
- Sponsor reserves the right to reject any entry that does not meet the terms & regulations or is inappropriate for public exhibition.
- Exhibition facilities have a professional security system and the exhibition is monitored.
- A 15% commission will be charged on all sales resulting from exhibit. Photographers will be notified of sale by phone and receive a letter by postal mail, which will include a W9 form that must be completed for payment.
- Sponsor reserves the right to use images of work and/or exhibition for publicity.
- All works must remain on display throughout the exhibition viewing times. No early pick-ups.
- By submission of entries, the artist accepts all conditions and terms set forth in this prospectus.

DIVISIONS

Professional – Entrants who earn all or a significant portion of their income from the sale of their photographs.

Amateur – Entrants who are hobbyists/enthusiasts and do not earn significant income from the sale of their photographs.

Monochrome – Black & White and Toned Prints

Color – Color Prints and Hand Colored Photographs

JUDGE

We are pleased to announce the judge for this exhibition is Kevin Foltz. J. Kevin Foltz is a wanderer. He has worked for thirty years as a traveling photographer with a large variety of clients ranging from airline magazines, resorts, inns, and restaurants to Western Union and the Sony Corporation. Recently relocated to Charleston from Miami, Kevin continues to work on travel and culinary projects for the custom publishing industry throughout the Americas and the Caribbean. Although still involved in photography works, he now devotes much of his time to making art in many new mediums. Kevin considers himself to be a folk artist, encountering his muse when roaming. In his work he allows imagery recorded on the film plane to become a platform from which he dives into subjective interpretations of moments in time. Foltz says, "As long as the art is made with the intention of honest and unique self-expression it is worthy of reflection."
